**Coach Trip is FREE!**

Your Committee has been regularly asked if we can arrange a Coach trip for you. We have therefore arranged, as a test of your support, a **FREE** coach trip to Historic Chatham Dockyard. You will only need to pay the **reduced (Group) entrance fee of £9.50!** The cost, with entry fee to most sites, would normally be over £25 as Adult entry alone is £15. We hope to have your support for this trip so we may consider outings further afield such as Windsor, Bath and, perhaps, even Paris? The Coach also has toilet and catering facilities. Please indicate on your return slip other places you might like to visit?

The Historic Chatham Dockyard is a large site (about 80 football pitches) and contains more areas of interest than can be seen in one day. These include Historic Ships and Architecture, National Museum Galleries including RNLi and Kent Police, many TV and film locations, together with displays of traditional ship building and more. Our **Forestdale Coach** pick-up points for this return trip are **(A) Bus Stop Z1, Fairfield Halls at 10.30am sharp** and then **(B) 10.45am 119/194 Bus Stop layby Monks Orchard junc. Bridle Rd/ Wickham Road, Shirley**. The journey takes one hour and we intend to **return at 4pm sharp**.

**More about Forestdale Coaches:** We aim to support this local family run operation, a small and very popular 'husband and wife' team. The owners Mr. & Mrs. Vic Holub, also act as the drivers. They started in September 1988 and currently operate the newer restyled Bova Futura Coach. Actually, they were the first to operate this and have the distinction of a Corgi model made in their honour. As a mark of their popularity, there is even a 'Waiting List' to become a Member for their own Scheduled trips. They operate throughout the UK and Continental Europe.
