## **CRYSTAL PALACE PARK** **Friday 16 August 2024**

Dear Croydon Fellowship Member,

Crystal Palace Park is a large park in south-east London, listed on the Register of Historic Parks and Gardens, and laid out in the 1850's as a pleasure ground. The park is quite large so we will just cover the bottom part this time and leave the top for another walk. The walk is mostly flat with just a few inclines and is step-free. Some of the paths are gravelly so please wear appropriate footwear.

We will see the small animal farm, the dinosaurs around the Lower Lake, the fishing lake, the maze, the concert bowl and the sports centre.

The walk will take 2 to 2 ½ hours and we will get back to Crystal Palace station between 16:00 & 16:30 hrs.

**DATE – Friday 16 August 2024**

**TIME – 13:45 hrs to set off at 14:00 hrs.**

**MEET – Outside Crystal Palace Railway Station at the main entrance.**

Please use public transport (train or buses 157, 249, 358, 410, & 432)  
as parking is limited and restricted.

**COST – Free**

Parking available in side roads off Anerley Hill and also in park itself - nearest carpark is the National Sports Centre one about a 5 minute walk from the station, access via Anerley Hill by the station.
