All You Can Eat Brunch

Wednesday, 31st January, 2024 Toby Carvery, South Croydon

Many of us are already aware of the treats available at lunchtimes in the Toby Carvery, South Croydon.

But did you know that Toby also run an "All You Can Eat" breakfast buffet? Maybe you're already a fan? Or maybe you've heard about it and would like to try, but are unsure how it would work? Following the success of our first "Brunch" in October, we're going again!

The restaurant opens at 9am, and we shall be there on **Wednesday**, **31**st **January** from **9.30am**. The breakfast/brunch buffet is available until it is cleared away at 11am, so you can join us at any time till about 10.30am and the full spread will await you.

You just go to the bar and say "I'd like a breakfast, please", pay your £5.99 and you'll be handed cutlery and a napkin. We hope to reserve a few tables together, so choose a seat and then help yourself (as many times as you like) from the buffet loaded with bacon, fried eggs, sausages, hash browns, baked beans, mushrooms, tomatoes, savoury potato, bacon, cheese & onion hash – and, because it's a Toby, bacon-flavoured Yorkshire puddings and gravy. Sauces are available, and there's a toaster on hand, supplied with sliced bread, spread, marmalade and jam.

Items such as vegan sausages and scrambled egg can be ordered at the bar when you pay for your breakfast, and are specially cooked to order.

Alternatively, lighter items are available, if you'd like to join us but that all sounds like too much to handle – a selection of cereals, or toast and jam, for £1.29, or a bowl of porridge with fruit compote for £1.49.

Drinks are extra, but they'll happily give you a free glass of water. However, as it's a pub, you could treat yourself to a fruit juice, a Baileys latte or a pint of Guinness. But if you'd just like a cup of tea or a filter coffee, then that's bottomless too, so just come and say "hello" to us and the Fellowship will pay for your cup.
