## *All You Can Eat Breakfast*

**9–11am, Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2025**

**Toby Carvery, 415 Brighton Road  
South Croydon CR2 6ES**

Many of us are already aware of the treats available at lunchtimes in a Toby Carvery.

But did you know that Toby also run an “All You Can Eat” breakfast buffet? Maybe, like us, you’re already a fan – or perhaps you’d like to try it, but are unsure how it would work? *Then why not join us at the Toby Carvery in South Croydon and we’ll be glad to show you the ropes!*

**The restaurant opens at 8am. We shall be there from 9am, and you can join us at any time up till about 10.30am and the full spread will await you (the breakfast buffet and coffee station are cleared away at 11am).**

**You just go to the bar and say “I’d like breakfast, please”, pay your £7.49 and you’ll be given your knife and fork. If you’d like unlimited tea, decaff or filter coffee for £2.99, just pay for a cup at the bar along with your breakfast – or if you’d prefer fruit juice or a cappuccino, or just a glass of water, ask the barista. Then join us at our reserved tables. Your “unlimited” drinks are available at the tea/coffee station beside the buffet. The iced water dispenser is located beside the till.**

Then you help yourself (as many times as you like) from the buffet loaded with bacon, fried eggs, sausages, hash browns, baked beans, mushrooms, tomatoes and their savoury potato, bacon, cheese & onion hash – and, *because it’s a Toby*, bacon-flavoured Yorkshire puddings and gravy. Sauces are available, and there’s a toaster on hand, supplied with sliced bread, spreads, marmalade and jam. *(Relax, you don’t have to take it all!)*

Vegan sausages or scrambled eggs can be ordered at the bar when you pay for your breakfast, and are specially cooked to order.

Alternatively, lighter items are available, if you’d like to join us but that all sounds like too much to handle – Toby also offers a selection of cereals, or toast and jam, or a bowl of porridge with fruit compote for **£1.99**. *If you don’t want to eat breakfast, you could still just buy a coffee or drink at the bar, and join us for a chat.*
